Strengthening institutional and technical capacity for SCP project just launched in Argentina, Bhutan, and Rwanda. The project aims at supporting the three targeted countries in addressing: 1) strengthening of the national institutional and technical capacities needed to create a culture of SCP across governments and societies, 2) the use of scientific methodologies and tools to support the design and implementation of strategic SCP policies and instruments and identifying high-impact sectors and area for intervention, 3) access to expert networks and existing solutions.
