10-Year Framework of Programmes for Sustainable Consumption & Production (10YFP) Board & SCP Partners Meeting,

24th February, 2024, UNEP HQ, Gigiri, Nairobi

Background:

The 10YFP Board and SCP Partners Meeting, on February 24, 2024, at UNEP HQ in Nairobi, Kenya will take place within the context of the UNEA6, contributing to its theme of "Effective, inclusive, and sustainable multilateral actions against climate change, biodiversity loss, and pollution". The sixth session of the UN Environment Assembly (UNEA6) has been identified as the backdrop for this meeting given its focus on addressing interconnected planetary crises. The 10YFP Board and SCP Partners Meeting will also connect with the themes of the 31st Meeting of the International Resource Panel within the context of the launch of its latest Global Resources Outlook Report.

Objectives:

The one-day meeting convened by the 10YFP Board will foster greater understanding of the role of sustainable consumption and production for achieving UNEA6 objectives and its role within the context of specific UNEA6 resolutions under consideration. The meeting will also serve as a platform for highlighting sustainable consumption and production (SCP) and circular economy approaches, showcasing best practices and relevant initiatives linked to the implementation of the Global Strategy for Sustainable Consumption & Production (2022-2030) and the Results Framework & Budget (2023-2024). The meeting is open to the 10YFP Board, the co-leads of the 10YFP Programmes & Initiatives, SCP partners, member states and stakeholders.

Thematic sessions:

The meeting will highlight five areas of sustainable consumption & production approaches for promoting effective, inclusive, and sustainable solutions. These areas are also relevant for several UNEA6 draft resolutions and the UNEA6 Ministerial Declaration. They include: Stepping up efforts for enhancing the circular economy transition domestically, regionally and globally and Circularity of a resilient and low-carbon sugar cane agroindustry and Sustainable Lifestyles and Enhancing the role and viability of regional environment ministerial forums and regional offices in achieving multilateral cooperation in tackling environmental challenges and Promoting synergistic approaches to address the interlinked global crises of climate change, biodiversity loss and pollution and support sustainable development.

The five thematic sessions will exemplify practical multilateral actions across high impact sectors:



- Supporting the implementation and monitoring of the 2022-2030 Global Strategy on Sustainable Consumption and Production: including by discussing the importance of a Global Dialogue on SCP;
- ii) **Understanding country needs and opportunities** to use standards and digital tools for sharing relevant product information along supply and value chains;
- iii) Environmental accounting principles and disclosure measures for businesses: the role of a **Global Circularity Protocol for business**;
- iv) Accelerating action to strengthen the environmental dimension of food systems transformation: including through circular bioeconomy approaches in agricultural value-chains,
- v) **Promoting scientific and data-driven** approaches to promote SCP: closing the SDG data gap and accelerate the **implementation** of the circular economy.
