**‘Delivering on sustainable low-carbon lifestyles – Mainstreaming Low-Carbon Sustainable Lifestyles through innovative initiatives or upscaling of successful high-impact initiatives’ is the theme of the 4<sup>th</sup> Sustainable Lifestyles and Education Programme call for project proposals.** [The Japan Ministry of the Environment](#) and [the Sustainable Lifestyles and Education Programme](#) require for all projects to include CO2 emissions reduction as an indicator and scientific estimation of CO2 emission reductions. **Closing for Small-scale and Medium-Scale Projects is the 10<sup>th</sup> of January 2019.** Information, guidelines for applicants and eligibility criteria [here](#).



**Call for applications under the Partnership Fund with SDG 12 as a focus area!** The [P4G Partnership Fund](#) offers financial support and targeted assistance to public-private partnerships that are advancing innovative strategies to achieve the following five Sustainable Development Goals:

- Clean Energy
- Sustainable Cities
