

One Planet network inputs are included in the High-Level Political Forum review of Sustainable Development Goal 8. The One Planet network's [Economic growth and natural resource use: Breaking-up with 'Business as Usual'](#) was presented as an official input to the review of SDG 8, at the [Expert Group Meeting on SDG 8](#). This goal, on 'Decent Work and Economic Growth' is being reviewed at the [2019 High-Level Political Forum](#) (HLPF).

	<p>One Planet Programmes are working together to optimize the most important asset in the network: our collective knowledge! On May 22nd in Paris, a professionally-facilitated workshop on knowledge management was held as the annual One Planet network coordination desk meeting. The workshop focused on knowledge management’s central role in both sustainable development and the achievement of specific targets. 	<p>Our Sustainable Lifestyles and Education Programme’s ‘Good Life Goals’ are now available in Swedish! The Good Life Goals, already available in Chinese, English, French, German, Japanese, Portuguese, and Spanish, have now been translated into Swedish! The newly translated goals were launched earlier this June in Stockholm and can also be seen in a live street exposition in Linköping this summer. The life-size exhibition now spans the length of the main street, where an estimated 500 000 citizens will have the chance to view the installations.</p>

This year, as part of the ‘Act Now’ campaign to engage people in the global effort to tackle climate change through healthy and sustainable food choices, chefs from around the world were took part in the #ActNow Food Challenge!
