




UNWTO, leads of our Sustainable Tourism programme, have launched the ['Sustainable Tourism Policy Talks'](#)! The #SDGsTourismTalks are a series of short videos where Ministers of Tourism are invited to share their vision on the implementation of tourism policies and the contribution of the sector to the achievement of SDG12 and other connected SDGs.



UN Environment, an advisory committee member of our Sustainable Tourism Programme, has launched ['Roadmap for Low Carbon and Resource Efficient Accommodation in the Dominican Republic.'](#) The report identifies three systemic solutions to reduce emissions and improve resource efficiency for resilient tourism in the Dominican Republic. Two years of research, data collection and analysis have led to the identification of environmental hotspots relating to GHG emissions.

The ['Baseline Report on the Integration of Sustainable Consumption and Production Patterns into Tourism Policies'](#) has been launched by UNWTO, in collaboration with UN Environment and with support from the Government of France. This research project has the objective to gain insights on the integration of sustainable production and consumption into tourism policies, is based on 101 tourism policies from around the world and is the first global assessment of SCP policy instruments in national tourism. The report also contributes to visualizing the progress achieved towards the implementation of [SDG Target 12.B](#). By recommending five strategic approaches to embrace the existing opportunities and face the environmental challenges of the sector, the report ultimately aims to

inspire stakeholders and encourage them to advance SDGs implementation through sustainable tourism.
